The highest recorded temperature in Nazareth is 109.0°F (42.8°C), which was recorded in May. The lowest recorded temperature in Nazareth is 27.0°F (-2.8° C), which was recorded in January.

Taxation

Tax in Nazareth is VAT, VAT is applied to the majority of goods and services, including imported goods and services. As of October 1 2015, the rate was lowered to 17%, from 18%. Before that , it was raised to 18% from 17% on June 2 2013, which it stood at after being raised from 16% on September 1 2012. An Israeli resident company is subject to corporate income tax on its worldwide income and to capital gains tax on worldwide capital gains. The basic tax rate for companies is 23%.
