**Rahat** (Arabic: رهط, Hebrew: רהט) is a predominantly Bedouin city in the Southern District of **Israel**. In 2019 it had a population of 71,437. As such, it is the largest Bedouin city in the world, and the only one in **Israel** to have city status.

- 1: In Rahat they don't only speak hebrew they also speak Arabic

- 3: In 2009 the city was not able to pay its water fees and the water supply was disconnected for 5 hours
- 4: Today Rahat has a water company that is in charge of supplying water and taking care of the sewers.
