I. Call to Order

Linda Aristondo called the meeting to order at 6:39 pm and reminded everyone in attendance to sign up for public comments if they wished to speak.

- The Annual Raise the Roof Breakfast taking place on Monday, June 17th will introduce the Harlem Hebrew Community to the school's incoming leaders; Emily Lynn Carson, Head of School for Instruction and Jason Epting, Head of School for Operations and Community.
- The school's rooftop playground is closed for the remainder of the school year.
- Hiring for the next school year is ongoing.
- MAP testing has been concluded.
- Israel Day is scheduled to take place on June 18th.
- A Song Celebration is scheduled to take place on June 21st.
- A therapy dog, Watson, has been made two visits to the school to great fanfare.
- June 28th is the last day of school for the current year.
- Interim Head of School, Meghan Barrios, reminded the board that this was her last board meeting as Interim Head of School and she would be returning to her position at the Hebrew Public network. The board congratulated her and thanked her for her hard work.
