LOWER SCHOOL K-4

- 1 Box of Sharpened No. 2 Pencils
- Colored Pencils or markers
- 4 Marble Notebooks
- 2 Pocket Folders
- Ruler
- 1 Pack of Index Cards

Tips for Setting up Your Work Area-
