New Public Charter School Planned for Stamford

Stamford, CT - June 21, 2024 – Hebrew Public, a national organization leading a national movement of exceptional, diverse public charter schools, is excited to announce plans for the opening of OLAM Public Charter School, a new free public school in Stamford, aimed at providing a rigorous and inclusive education to students from all backgrounds.

Modeled after the successful Hebrew Public schools in Brooklyn and Staten Island, OLAM Public Charter School will offer a comprehensive curriculum that includes English, math, science, social studies, Modern Hebrew, and specials like arts, music and sports. The school's educational approach emphasizes global citizenship, critical thinking, and cross-cultural understanding.

Scheduled to open in Fall 2026, OLAM Public Charter School will initially serve over 100 students in kindergarten and first grade, eventually expanding to serve grades K-8. The school will provide an environment of academic excellence, cultural appreciation, and community engagement.

In preparation for the school's opening, we are hosting a series of informational meetings and gatherings that are being met with great interest and demand for a school of choice like OLAM Public Charter School.

Angelica Gorrio, Stamford community organizer states, "We are thrilled to bring this unique educational model to Stamford. Our goal is to create a vibrant learning community where students are inspired to achieve their fullest potential while developing a deep appreciation for cultural diversity."
