1. Call to Order

David Sorkin made a motion to open the meeting at 7:02 pm.

2. Adoption of the January 2026 Meeting Agenda

David Sorkin asked for a motion to adopt the January 2026 meeting agenda. Noemi Zibuts made the motion, Anna Maftser seconded, and the motion was carried unanimously.

3. Approval of the December 2025 Meeting Minutes

4. Leadership Report

A collaborative PowerPoint presentation was shared with the board that provided updates on school performance, student culture, recruitment, facilities, and network initiatives. Leadership reported that mid-year interim assessments are underway, including mock state exams and iReady and MAP testing, with a deeper data review planned for the February Education and Accountability meeting. School culture highlights included recognition programs such as Dolphin Dive incentives, honor roll and attendance awards, and iReady achievement celebrations, as well as recent community events and upcoming family-teacher conferences, which typically see 75–80% participation. Updated KPIs showed attendance at approximately 91%, below the 95% target, with leadership actively monitoring individual cases impacting the rate. Recruitment updates indicated stable enrollment and application numbers trending ahead of last year, following the direct mail campaign, with increased interest from transfer families. A facilities update noted continued progress with the landlord on phased building improvements beginning in the 2026–27 school year. Network updates included a save-the-date for a spring fundraiser and plans for a March board presentation on the rebranding initiative. The board discussed the update, and no action was taken.
